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

### 143 Shared resources of good practices collection

1. **Related with the method** (translation of consent forms; interview guides; demographic data; interview protocol; invitation letter)
2. **Related with the interviews** (links to the videos; documents with the transcription and translation of the responses; and documents, flyers, disciplinary referrals adopted in interviewed schools...)
3. **Related with other resources of good practices** (pictures and documents exemplifying good practices)
4. **Related with PBS implementation in partner schools – according to the IO5**

## SOME FINAL NOTES

- **Implication for practice:**
  - the categorization system of good practices can serve as the basis for analyzing and cooperating with school teams in their process of implementing the PBS
  
- **Research:**
  - Content analysis of what the school principals – 8 principals – referred to be good practices and analyze the congruence with the literature – Cross-country comparison
  
- **How to keep the Repository active?**
  - This takes time and effort, but would constitute an important resource
